

# Welcome to the Lloydkade

Dear Captain,

First of all, I would like to wish you an enjoyable stay on the Lloydkade. This berth is situated almost in the heart of Rotterdam and in the immediate vicinity of houses. In order to be able to retain this berth for shipping, I would like to ask you to generate as little noise as possible, so that residents and shipping can continue to exist alongside each other as enjoyably as possible.

For this reason, I would like to ask you to cooperate in:

- Reducing sound pollution occurring as a consequence of using generators;
- Preventing as much as possible, activities that can create sound pollution;
- Reducing exhaust fumes to a minimum;
- Adjusting deck-lighting, so that these are not focused on houses along the quay;
- Berthing, so that the exhaust fumes are blown towards the riverside;

The general terms and conditions of the Port Authority N.V. do not allow you to:

- Carry out repairs that result in sound pollution between 22.00 and 07.00 hours;
- Bunker between 22.00 and 07.00 hours;
- Remain on the berth for more than 72 hours;
- Berth with deck cargo on board;
- Berth with a tanker (excepting a fuel storage ship during bunkering);
- Carry out loading and unloading.

If you are unable to comply with the above rules for any reason, please contact the Harbour Coordination Centre (HCC). Another berth may be available for you.
