

APPLICATION FOR EXEMPTION FROM INLAND PORT DUES REPAIR (PART I, SKIPPER/OWNER)

If you use ports, waters and port facilities in the municipalities of Rotterdam, Vlaardingen, Schiedam, Dordrecht, Zwijndrecht, Papendrecht and/or the jetties or quays of Vopak Terminal Vlaardingen, you are obliged to pay inland port dues.

However, if you use the port in one of the above municipalities for repair work at a wharf, you may be eligible for exemption from the inland port dues.

This is subject to the following conditions:

- The repairs must be necessary for the operation of a vessel;
- The repairs may not take longer than strictly necessary;
- The owner/skipper of the vessel must submit a written application for exemption from the inland port dues to the Port of Rotterdam Authority within 24 hours of arrival at the wharf.
