



With 25 multi-user berths in the Maasvlakte, Europoort, Waalhaven, Botlek and Dordrecht, the Port of Rotterdam offers flexible, efficient and risk-free ship-to-ship transfers facilities for all kinds of cargo. Unhindered by tides or locks, ships of all



sizes have 24/7 access to the buoys and dolphins in Rotterdam's sheltered waters. The buoys and dolphins are therefore an attractive addition to the facilities at the terminals in the port and an excellent alternative for ship-to-ship transfers at offshore locations on the open sea.
